

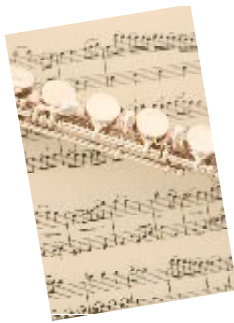


## Catawba Community Music is Now offering Music Opportunities at North Hills Christian School

The Catawba Community Music Program, a non-degree granting program of Catawba College, is designed to provide a variety of quality musical experiences including private lessons, music classes and performance opportunities to help students of all ages and abilities in Salisbury and the surrounding areas develop lifelong musical foundations and skills. We believe that an education in the arts is one of the most essential and enriching experiences a child, youth or adult can enjoy.

**Violin Class for Beginners (ages 7 and up)** is designed to meet the needs of the beginning violinist. Students start with fundamentals and progress to solo and ensemble playing. (Instructor, Dr. Daniel Skidmore; Wednesday 9:30 – 10:15; 12 week class; Tuition cost \$150 – does not include instrument)



### **Woodwinds Class for Beginners**

is designed to provide beginning woodwinds instruction to Middle School and High School students. Instruments include flute, clarinet and saxophone. (Instructor, Debbie Koontz; Tuesday 2:10 – 2:55; 12 week class; Tuition cost \$150 – does not include instrument)

**Private Instruction** (30 minute weekly lessons; 12 week semester; Tuition Cost \$210 – does not include instrument) is offered for

students on the following instruments:

**Violin** – ages 7 and up (Instructor, Dr. Daniel Skidmore; individual lessons to be scheduled)

**Saxophone, Flute and Clarinet** - ages 10 and up (Instructor, Debbie Koontz; individual lessons to be scheduled)

**Songwriting Class** is designed to introduce High-School students to the art and craft of songwriting. Topics will include melody, rhythm/style, harmony, form, and lyrics as well as the nature of aesthetics and the place of popular song within modern culture. No formal music training is necessary. (Instructor, Derek Daisey; Class time TBA; 12 week class; Tuition cost \$150 – does not include instrument)

**PAYMENT POLICIES:**

Class size is limited and student will not be considered registered until payment of the nonrefundable \$15 (per family) annual registration fee, at least half of tuition costs, and all music/materials fees are submitted with the completed registration form. A \$15.00 Late Fee will be charged on payments made after scheduled payment dates (October 29-fall and March 17-spring). Students are expected to continue lessons for the duration of the semester. A partial refund is available for private lessons if the student gives a notice to withdraw before the third lesson. After the third lesson, no refunds will be given. In the case of class enrollment, **no refund can be issued once a class has started.** All withdrawals are subject to the non-refundable registration fee.

**DISCOUNTS:**

- Families with Multiple Enrollments: A family registered for 2 or more Private Lessons or Classes may receive a 10% discount on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and/or any additional registrations on Class Tuition or Private Lesson Tuition with the 1<sup>st</sup> enrollment tuition paid at full rate. Discount applies to the lesser tuition amount.
- Catawba College Faculty and Staff employees, spouse or children may receive a 10% discount on all Class, Ensemble or Private Lesson Tuition.

**CANCELLATIONS:**

Full refunds will be made automatically if the Community Music Program cancels a course. Private lessons or classes cancelled by the instructor will be rescheduled. Once enrolled, students are expected to attend all lessons. Catawba Community Music has a no makeup policy. In case of severe weather, cancellations will be in conjunction with the Rowan-Salisbury public school closings.
