



2026 - 2027 Tuition Rates & Fees

NON-REFUNDABLE, ONE-TIME FEES:

\$150 Early Education New Student Application Fee

\$150 Lower School (Kindergarten - 4th Grade) New Student Application Fee

\$165 Upper School (5th - 12th Grade) New Student Application Fee

- Application fee is due for all prospective students prior to Entrance Assessment and Family/Student Interview

\$400 Enrollment Fee (for students enrolling in Kindergarten - 12th Grade) - Enrollment Fee is due with Enrollment Packet

- \$800 maximum per family. The enrollment fee will be reduced to \$200 for returning families enrolling a third child.

ANNUAL TUITION:

Early Education (Preschool/Junior Kindergarten) - \$9,360 (\$180/week) *New Year-Round Program

Lower and Upper School (Kindergarten through 12th Grade) - \$11,800

VICTOR Program - Grade tuition plus \$5,400

Tuition rates cover such items as supplemental student accident insurance, designated classroom and teaching supplements, school concerts, competitions, athletic costs, one copy of a yearbook, and most field trips.

AIM PROGRAM:

All Grades - \$540/class, with a maximum of \$5,400

AIM Advisory - \$1,080

FACTS Financial and Additional Information:

All Tuition Plans are billed through FACTS Financial

Automatic Payment Options include:

- Monthly drafts (June – May) from a checking account or credit card
- FACTS will assess an additional processing fee for credit card drafts
- Lump sum drafts, either annually in July or semi-annually in July and December.
 - *Families paying semi-annually receive a \$50 discount per student
 - *Families paying annually receive a \$100 discount per student

Incidental costs are family-specific and billed/drafted, separate from tuition, through FACTS Incidental Billing by monthly invoice. Examples of incidental costs include before/after care, emergency lunches, and tutoring (outside of the AIM program).

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES:

* All families can apply for assistance to reduce their total tuition.

Families who do not qualify for a scholarship receive a 10% discount on additional students after the oldest.

*** NCSEAA Opportunity and ESA+ Scholarship –**

Opportunity Scholarship – For students entering Kindergarten through 12th Grade. Online application, opens annually in February, renewed annually

Income-based Tiers, **2026-2027 awards amounts:**

1 Max \$7,942

2 Max \$7,148

3 Max \$4,766

4 Max \$3,574

ESA+ Award – For students entering Kindergarten through 12th grade, with an IEP Online application, opens in February, renewed annually

Award amounts: \$9,000 or \$17,000

*** FACTS Financial Aid -**

For students entering Kindergarten through 12th grade only. A secondary, need-based scholarship

Online application, open through enrollment season, must apply annually. Awards are awarded as funds are available and can be applied to both grade level and VICTOR/AIM tuition costs.

2026-2027 Award Amounts:

Kindergarten – 12 Grade: Max \$6,490 (toward standard tuition cost)

VICTOR/AIM Program: Max \$9,460 (toward standard tuition and program costs)
