Summer Reading Directions

- 1. Have your child choose at least 1 book from the provided reading list to read. All rising 2^{nd} graders are expected to read a minimum of one book.
- 2. Choose an activity to complete for 20 minutes each time you read and record the name of the book and a parent signature in the square on the map. Let your child place 1 treasure sticker into the square once you have completed the written task. All rising 2ndgraders are expected to complete a minimum of 10 different activities from the Summer Reading Treasure Map.
- 3. After your child has completed a book, please help them to write down 3 facts from the book on the provided fact cards and place them into their treasure box. Please complete this activity for each book read.
- 4. On the first day of school, please have your child bring in their treasure chest filled with their Summer Reading Treasure Map and fact cards in order to receive their prize.

Prizes will be awarded as shown below:

Bronze Medal - 1 book read from the summer reading list + 10 activities completed from the Summer Reading Treasure Map

Silver Medal - 2 books read from the summer reading list + 20 activities completed from the Summer Reading Treasure Map

Gold Medal - 3 books read from the summer reading list + 30 activities completed from the Summer Reading Treasure Map
