To earn a gold medal you will need to read 3 books from the list provided, write down 3 facts from each of the books (9 facts total) and complete a total of 30 activities on the Summer Reading Treasure Map.

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Summer Reading Directions

1. Have your child choose at least 1 book from the provided reading list to read. All rising 2nd graders are expected to read a minimum of one book.
2. Choose an activity to **complete for 20 minutes each time you read**. Parents must sign the square on the map to have this activity count towards your goal. Let your child color the square once you have completed the task on the map. All rising 2nd graders are expected to complete a minimum of 10 different activities from the Summer Reading Treasure Map.
3. After your child has completed a book, please help them to write down 3 facts from the book on the provided Fact Sheet document. Please complete this activity for each book read.
4. On the first day of school, please have your child bring in their fact sheet and Summer Reading Treasure Map in order to receive their prize.

Prizes will be awarded as shown below:

Bronze Medal - 1 book read from the summer reading list + 10 activities completed from the Summer Reading Treasure Map + 3 facts

Silver Medal - 2 books read from the summer reading list + 20 activities completed from the Summer Reading Treasure Map + 6 facts

Gold Medal - 3 books read from the summer reading list + 30 activities completed from the Summer Reading Treasure Map + 9 facts
