- 2. Choose an activity to **complete for 20 minutes each time you read**. Parents must sign the square on the map to have this activity count towards your goal. - 3. After your child has completed a book, please help them to write down 3 facts from the book on the provided Fact Sheet document. Please complete this activity for each book read.
- 4. On the first day of school, please have your child bring in their fact sheet and Summer Reading Treasure Map in order to receive their prize.

Prizes will be awarded as shown below:

Bronze Medal - 1 book read from the summer reading list + 10 activities completed from the Summer Reading Treasure Map + 3 facts

Silver Medal - 2 books read from the summer reading list + 20 activities completed from the Summer Reading Treasure Map + 6 facts
