Book in a Bag

Directions:

1. Read your book.
2. Decorate a bag with a scene from the book and your title. You may use the one provided or a different bag.
3. Place 10 objects inside the bag that represents significant aspects from the book.
4. Write the report (can be written in report format or on index cards and placed inside the bag):
 - a. Write one opening paragraph with an overview/summary of the book.
 - b. Write one paragraph about each of the ten objects (total of 10 paragraphs) explaining the significance of each.

Grading:

10 points	Outside of bag (neat, colorful, title, author's name, student's name on bottom of the bag)
25 points	10 objects (need to have significance in the book)
5 points	Opening Paragraph (needs to have at least 5 sentences giving an overview of book)
50 points	10 paragraphs (Each paragraph needs at least 5 sentences telling about the object and its significance.)
10 points	Spelling/Grammar
