As we continue to strive for excellence in providing holistic education, I am thrilled to remind you of our Career Guidance support, which provides invaluable real-world experiences for students in 11th and 12th grades.

Our Career Guidance is designed to expose students to diverse career paths and industries, preparing them for success in their future endeavors. For our rising juniors (current 10th graders), we schedule a junior seminar class dedicated to exploring career interests through various inventories and exposure to different industries. This class helps students align their interests with potential career paths, providing them with the necessary tools to make informed decisions about their future.
