

Junior Kindergarten Immunization Requirements

All children in North Carolina must be vaccinated against certain diseases.

Immunization records are checked when a child enters an early childhood program.

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| 4 years or older (in child care only) | 4 DTaP | 3 Hep B | 3-4 Hib | 1 MMR | 3 Polio | 4 PCV | 1 Var |
| 4 years and older (and in kindergarten) | 5 DTaP | 3 Hep B | 3-4 Hib | 2 MMR | 4 Polio | 4 PCV | 2 Var |

North Carolina Vaccine-Specific Requirements

The North Carolina General Statutes (G.S. 130A-152(a)) require immunizations for every child present in this state. Every parent, guardian or person in loco parentis is responsible for ensuring that their child(ren) receive required immunizations.
