



Kindergarten & Lower School Victors:

Our youngest Victor's classroom will have a maximum of 10 students or less (depending on the overall need of the classroom each year) and has 1 full-time teacher and a part-time aide. This classroom age range is identified as Kindergarten through 4th grade. However, the classrooms are assessed each year to ensure the environment is right for our students. This class is very play-based and hands-on learning focused, but also applies a routine-based school structure through visual schedules and an increased support model.

Students participate in all subjects including:

- Reading
- Math
- Writing
- Bible
- History
- Science
- Fine Motor/Life Skills
- General electives

The pace of their school day is often slower and more structured than a standard classroom. The class focuses on supporting students to advocate for themselves and develop strong communication and social skills to prepare them for a standard classroom setting, if appropriate for their future.

Through close partnership with **Speech Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Behavioral Therapy**, our goal is to foster growth and independence for each and every student.

***Families may access occupational, speech, and behavioral therapy through trusted outside providers who partner with NHCS. These services are arranged separately from school programming. Once in place, services may be provided on campus, if necessary.**
