



Middle Victors:

Our Middle Victors classroom is identified as students aged 5th - 8th grade and officially caps at 10 students. However, it also evaluates the needs of individuals when considering placement and class numbers.

The class has 1 full time teacher and a part-time aide.

Our Middle Victors classroom is less play-based, but continues to have increased hands-on learning and applies a routine based school structure through visual schedules and an increased support model.

Students participate in all subjects including:

- Reading
- Math
- Writing
- Bible
- History
- Science
- Fine Motor/Life Skills (if applicable to student need)
- Join school electives with standard peers as they are able and ready.

Similarly, the pace of their school day is often slower and more structured than a standard classroom. The class focuses on supporting students to advocate for themselves and develop strong communication and social skills to prepare them for a standard classroom setting, if appropriate for their future.

Through close partnership with **Speech Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Behavioral Therapy**, our goal is to foster growth and independence for each and every student.

***Families may access occupational, speech, and behavioral therapy through trusted outside providers who partner with NHCS. These services are arranged separately from school programming. Once in place, services may be provided on campus, if necessary.**
