Our newest Victors classroom is offered to students in High School and is identified as our **SPARK** Program (Students Proclaiming a Risen King).

This program is still an academic program and includes all standard subjects of school at a modified level. However, it also works with students to prepare them for life within their communities and after NHCS.

We encourage relationships with all students and involvement in other areas of the school by participating in events such as dances, festivals, our house program, prom, homecoming, sports, and more.

Students in this program will have a dedicated and individualized success plan where NHCS Staff partner with parents to identify goals for the student's future and what NHCS can do to support and guide them towards their goals.

## **Program Overview:**

The **SPARK** Program was created to serve students as a whole person and prepare them for the mission God has called them to after high school. Students are responsible for completing modules designed to build life skills and show mastery in a variety of areas students need for life beyond the classroom.

## **Program Objectives:**

To partner with students as young adults and their families as they prepare to transition from the school environment to their community.

Modules include a focus on:

- Independent living skills
- Safety and managing personal health
- Finance management
- Community living
- Workplace preparation
