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Assignment:

Complete the 2 part assignment. Bring your completed assignment with you on the first day of school.

Part 1:

Create a poster portraying the character of your choice from the novel From the Mixed-Up Files of Mrs. Basil E. Frankweiler.

- This can be a picture of just your character or a picture of a scene involving your character.
- Include on your poster a timeline of events involving your character in the story. The timeline should have only 5 events.

Part 2:

On a separate piece of paper, answer the following prompts in three to five complete sentences. (This includes capitalization and punctuation)

- 1. Describe the character. Include personality traits and physical characteristics as well as strengths and weaknesses.
- 2. What do you like about this character that made you choose this character for your poster?
- 3. Describe the setting of the story.
- 4. How did this character impact the story?
- 5. How does the story end for this character? Predict what might happen with this character in the story.

All students, please remember to bring this assignment with you to school on the first day. It will be recorded as your first grade in Language Arts. This will be a completion grade that can be used for extra credit or to replace your lowest English grade during Term 1.
